EAP Placement: Exam Correlation Matrix

The following table shows entry score requirements for each EAP level. Students are placed in an EAP level according to the lowest individual skill score on the test.

For example, a student with an IELTS 5.5 in Speaking and Listening, a 5.0 in Reading, and a 4.5 in Writing, will be placed in EAP Level 6.

The test score is only valid if it was taken no more than 18 months before arrival to Humber.

Completion of EAP Level 8 with a 60% gpa is equivalent to:

IELTS score of at least 6.0

TOELF score of at least 80 (iBT), 555 (PBT)

CAEL overall score of at least 60 (CAEL scores are rounded to nearest 10)

Completion of EAP Level 8 with:

- 60% GPA meets the language proficiency requirement for Humber Diploma Programs
- 75% GPA meets the language proficiency requirement for Humber Degree Programs
- 80% GPA meets the language proficiency requirement for Humber Post-Graduate Programs
