Pathways to Humber

- Placement into EAP using Humber's own online placement test:
The English Language Centre has its own online placement test. You can take this in your home country when you apply for a course at Humber. The test will assess your English level and tell you how many levels of EAP you need to study or if you can go directly into your program.
- Placement into EAP using IELTS or TOEFL
*The test scores are only valid if taken no more than 8 months before arrival to Humber.
- Placement into EAP on arrival at Humber

Conditional Admission to Humber Programs through EAP

International students enrolled in EAP may receive conditional offers of admission to most Humber programs.

Completion of EAP Level 8 meets the language proficiency requirements for admission to most Humber programs. For students completing Level 8 with no failed courses and with the appropriate grades (see below), no further IELTS or TOEFL testing is required.

EAP PATHWAYS:

- Level 8 completion with 60% > Humber diploma programs
- Level 8 completion with 75% > Humber degree programs
- Level 8 completion with 80% > Humber postgraduate programs

*Meeting the minimum language proficiency requirement does not guarantee admission to the program.

Summer Language Program (SLP)
