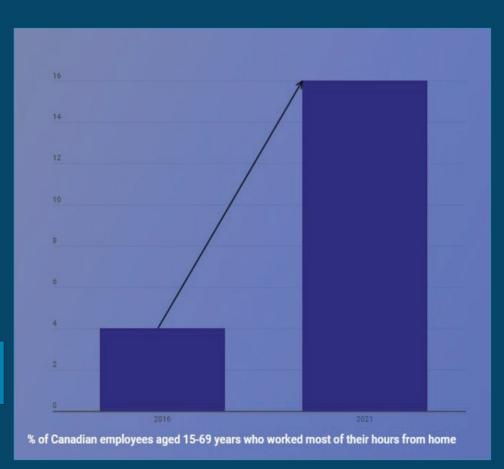

of those who opted for fully remote work were faced with mental health issues and that affected their performance.

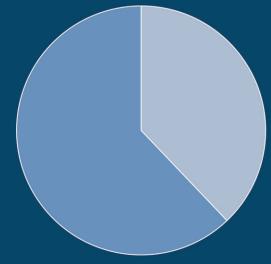

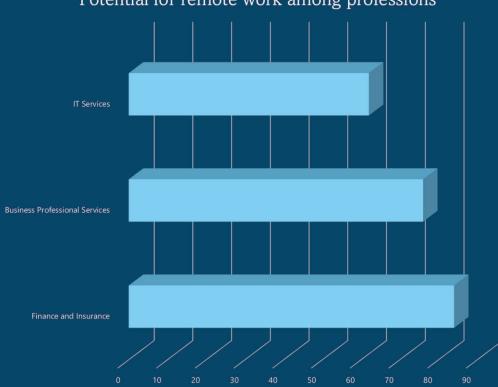
