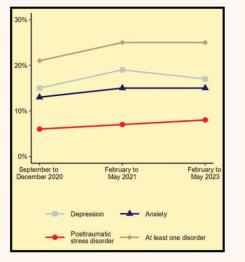

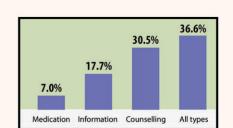


The prevalence of mood and anxiety

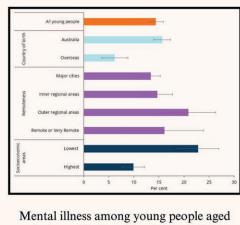
disorders in Canada increased from 2012 to

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5. Actively engage in mental health initiatives within schools, advocating for needs, prioritizing self-care practices, and seeking support when needed.
