WHAT IS JUBI?

- JETBURST: Our research team proposes a federal policy that is:
- **UNIVERSAL:** given to all Canadian residents aged 18+
- BASIC: \$2,000/month direct tax-free payment
- **INCOME:** to afford minimum standard of living expenses including housing and food

WE CAN AFFORD IT!

Progressive tax reforms can raise \$825B without increasing personal income taxes for the majority of Canadians.


JUBI REDUCES POVERTY


A simulation of JUBI using Statistics Canada's microsimulation model found:

The lowest income range would gain the most in average disposable income.



| Income Range | Average Income without UBI | Average Income with UBI |
|-----------------|----------------------------------|-------------------------------|
| <\$0 - \$10,000 | \$3,595 | \$26,591 |
| Overall | \$46,580 | \$65,556 |





Income inequality measured by the Gini coefficient would decrease by 28%.
