

JETBURST UBI: A LIFE RAFT FOR CANADIANS

WHAT IS JUBI?

- J** **JETBURST:** Our research team proposes a federal policy that is:
- U** **UNIVERSAL:** given to all Canadian residents aged 18+
- B** **BASIC:** \$2,000/month direct tax-free payment
- I** **INCOME:** to afford minimum standard of living expenses including housing and food

WE CAN AFFORD IT!

Progressive tax reforms can raise \$825B **without increasing personal income taxes for the majority of Canadians.**

JUBI REDUCES POVERTY

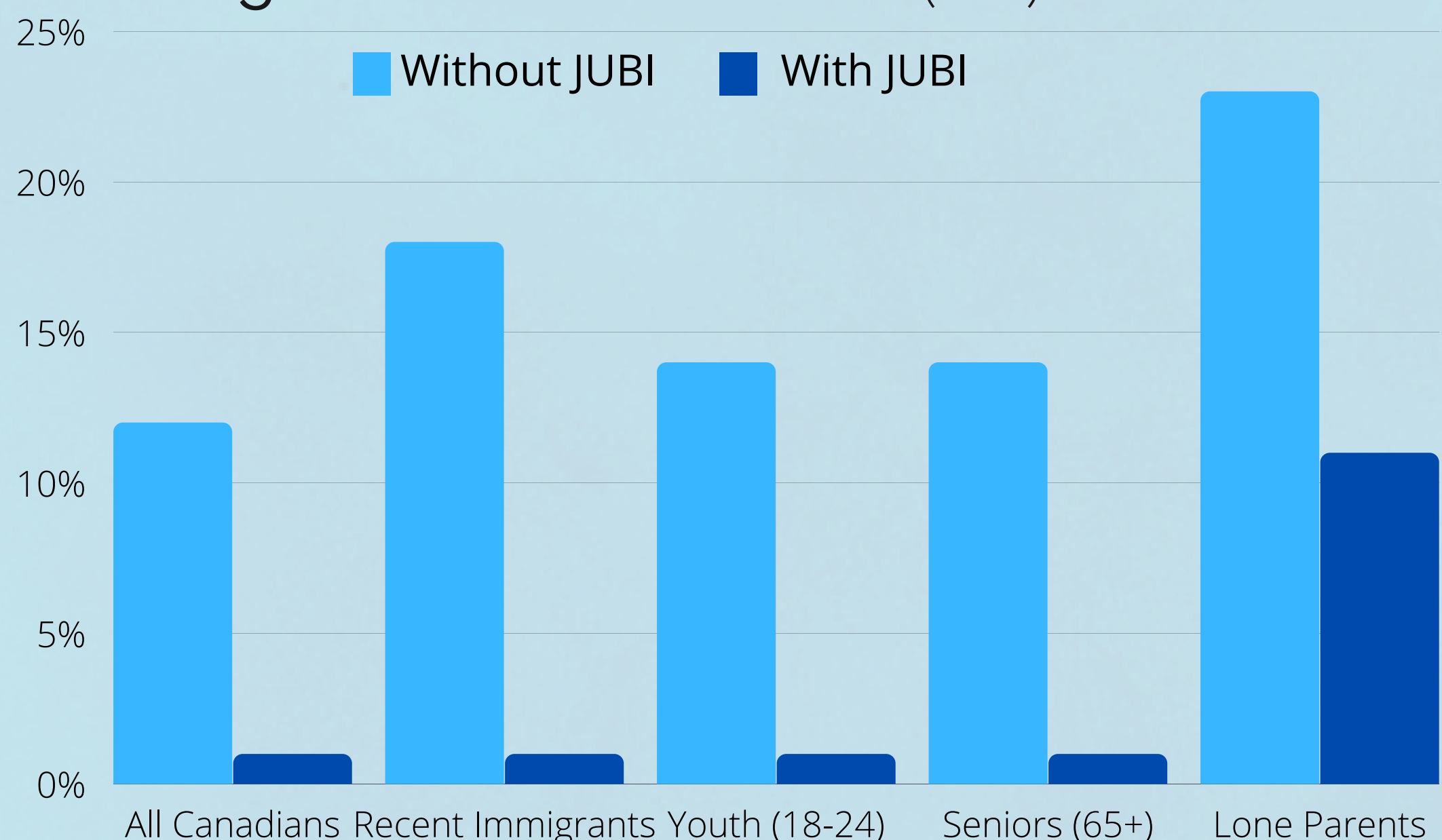
A simulation of JUBI using Statistics Canada's microsimulation model found:

The lowest income range would gain the most in average disposable income.

 **640%**

Income Range	Average Income without UBI	Average Income with UBI
<\$0 - \$10,000	\$3,595	\$26,591
Overall	\$46,580	\$65,556

Poverty rates would decrease for all Canadians, using a Low Income Measure (LIM) threshold.



Income inequality measured by the Gini coefficient would decrease by **28%**.
