




In Canada, menstruation typically begins between the ages of 10-14 years and ends at menopause, around 50 years of age.

Menstruators spend, on average, 6 years menstruating over the course of their lifetime





Use of Menstrual Cups can help replace

- •12 Tampons per period at 6% of the plastic waste and 7% of the cost
- •12 pads per period at 0.4% of the plastic waste and 5% of the cost
