Impact of Substance Abuse/ Drug use on youth



Substance abuse, as a disorder, refers to the abuse of illegal substances or the abusive use of legal substances. i.e. Alcohol, Cannabis Etc.

In Canada, approximately 21% of the population (about 6 million people) will meet the criteria for addiction in their lifetime.

25.1% of youth report use of substance abuse.
